



VIRTUAL SITE BASED PROGRAM

Virtual Site Based Mentoring (Beyond School Walls): This program is virtual through Zoom, Google Meets, etc. High school students, college students, or members of the community are matched with middle school students. They will meet once a week for the academic school year.

In this program we focus on empowering youth to become leaders, have high self-esteem and confidence, set goals for their future, and teach them important social skills to help them succeed in life.

OVERVIEW

- Matches will choose a set day/time to meet each week for the school year. Each session will be a minimum of 30 minutes.
- Matches will choose a set virtual platform (Zoom, Google Meets, etc.) they will use for the school year.
- Matches will receive weekly activity/discussion ideas from BBBS Staff. At the beginning of the match, BBBS staff will send out supplies for matches to use over the course of their match (construction paper, markers, glue, etc.)
- Matches will be given a monthly calendar of meeting days. Matches will not hold sessions during scheduled breaks or days off (spring break, Christmas break, etc.)
- Bigs will give BBBS staff the meeting link for each of your sessions.
- Bigs and Parent/Guardians will only exchange emails. Phone number, addresses, social media accounts, etc. will not be exchanged between Bigs, Littles, Parents/guardians.
- BBBS staff will check in monthly with Bigs, Littles, and Parents/Guardians.
