



HIGHER EDUCATION



There is more than one way to further your education after high school. Here is some information about three options for continuing your education.

Community College

- Provides a 2-year Associate's Degree
- Cost-effective for students, especially those who have not decided on a major
- Open admission
- Offers the option to transfer credits to a 4-year college
- Does not provide on-campus housing or extracurricular activities



College or University

- Offers a wide range of majors and consists of a more rigorous academic program
- Provides a 4-year Bachelor's degree
- Admission is required, and certain requirements must be met
- Offers on-campus housing and extracurricular activities



Trade or Vocational School

- Provides a certificate of completion
- Designed to give students the technical skills to prepare them for certain occupations that demand a specific set of skills
- Shorter time period than community college or university
- Cost effective option and has open admission
- No on-campus housing and extracurricular activities
