

HOW TO HELP YOUR LITTLE NAVIGATE SOCIAL MEDIA

KNOW THE BENEFITS AND RISKS OF SOCIAL MEDIA

- → <u>BENEFITS</u>: Connection, a source of information, enhance creativity, meet people with similar interests
- → <u>RISKS</u>: Reveal personal information to strangers, comparison to peers, being exposed to inappropriate upsetting content, cyberbullying

Instruct your Little on how to keep their privacy on the internet

- Don't post your address
- → Don't post inappropriate photos
- → Keep Instagram/Facebook/Twitter private so only close friends can seenot strangers
- → Use secret passwords, don't share them, and don't overuse them

Encourage your Little to confide in someone if they are experiencing cyberbullying. If your little is dealing with cyberbullying:

- → Reassure your Little that you support them.
- → Help your Little step away from the computer or device and take a break.
- → Contact your Littles parent/Guardian. If bullying is happening online, it might be happening offline, too. Recommend the parent/guardian to contact the bully's parent/guardian.
