I expressly acknowledge that I assume risk for any and all injuries and illnesses that may result. In consideration of the privilege of joining or using the YMCA, I hereby voluntarily release and discharge the YMCA of Marquette County, its agents, servants, and employees from any and all claims for injury, death, loss or damage that I or my child may suffer. I understand the YMCA of Marquette County is NOT responsible for personal property lost or stolen while members and/or program participants are using YMCA facilities or on YMCA premises.

We are committed to providing a safe and welcoming environment for all members, reciprocal members and guests. To promote safety and comfort for all, we ask individuals to act appropriately at all times when they are in our facilities and/or participating in our programs. We expect those using the YMCA to behave in a mature and responsible way and to respect the rights and dignity of others. Our Code of Conduct does not permit language or any action that can hurt or frighten another person or that falls below a generally accepted standard of conduct (Code of Conduct); specifically:

- Inappropriate attire including offensive wording on shirts/accessories;
- Angry or vulgar language including swearing, name-calling or shouting;
- Physical contact with another person in an angry or threatening way;
- Any demonstration of sexual contact or activity;
- Harassment or intimidation by words, gestures, body language or any other menacing behavior;
- Theft or behavior which results in the destruction of property;
- Carrying or concealing any weapons or devices/objects which may be used as weapons;
- Using or possessing illegal chemicals or alcohol in/on YMCA property or programs;
- Any other conduct of an inappropriate, threatening or offensive nature;
- Loitering is not permitted inside or outside the YMCA.

All reported incidents will be reviewed by YMCA management. When a violation of the Code of Conduct has occurred, the decision to suspend or terminate YMCA membership privileges will be made by YMCA management.
