Bowl for Kids' Sake Chance to Win Grand Prize of \$50,000
April 5, 2008
Marquette County Bowl For Kids' Sake Event

1. Employees, agents, successors, and assignees of Big Brothers Big Sisters of Marquette County, Inc., its advertisers and promotional companies, as well as family and household members of the same, shall be ineligible to participate in the Grand Prize drawing and shall be ineligible for any prize covered herein.
2. Names and likenesses of Bowl for Kids' Sake Grand Prize winner(s) may be used by Big Brothers Big Sisters of Marquette County, Inc. for promotional purposes without further compensation to Big Brothers Big Sisters of Marquette County, Inc. or the winner(s).
3. To be eligible to participate in the drawing, bowlers must turn in \$100 of **PAID** pledges at their bowling shift on April 5, 2008 at Country Lanes in Ishpeming or Superior Lanes in Marquette. Bowlers receive an entry into the drawing for every \$100 in **PAID** pledges.
4. From the bowlers with \$100 in **PAID** pledges, ten finalists will be chosen by random drawing from each bowling shift at each bowling alley, Country Lanes in Ishpeming and Superior Lanes in Marquette. There are six bowling shifts for a maximum of sixty (60) finalists. Each of the sixty finalists must be 18 years of age or older and have a government issued photo identification card.
5. **All finalists must return to Superior Lanes in Marquette on Saturday, April 5, 2008 at 8:30 p.m. to be eligible for the final drawing.**
6. Each of the finalists will select an envelope out of a maximum of sixty (60) envelopes. Ten of the envelopes will contain a winning message to become one of the ten finalists.

7. The ten (10) winning ticket holders will receive an envelope. One (1) of the envelopes will have the winning message to draw for the chance to win \$50,000.
8. **The winning contestant will select two (2) envelopes from fifteen (15) envelopes. Two (2) of the envelopes out of the fifteen (15) contain a prize winning message and exactly thirteen (13) contain non-winning messages.**
9. **If the final contestant selects the two (2) envelopes containing the prize-winning messages, the contestant will win the \$50,000 prize. If the final contestant does not select the two (2) envelopes containing the prize-winning messages, the final contestant will win \$500.**
